

## **COVENANT GROUP FORMAT (1 hour meeting)**

1. Centering silence (leader ends with Amen) and Opening Prayer for Guidance (from *Book of Common Prayer*)

**OPENING PRAYER:** Heavenly Father, in you we live and move and have our being: We humbly pray you so to guide and govern us by your Holy Spirit, that in all the cares and occupations of our life we may not forget you, but may remember that we are ever walking in your sight; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

1. Please share: How have I experienced God's presence in my life during this week? (brief introductions if new members join)
2. Look – take a look at some area of our every day life (2 or 3 answer the study questions for the rest of the group)
3. Book – Take the challenge to the scripture & see it in the light of God's word
4. Took – What can we take away from our meeting into the week ahead
5. End with prayer requests or reports of answered prayer
6. Pray for the person next to you:

Lord, I lift up \_\_\_\_\_ and ask you to help and bless him/her in the coming week. (*You may add something specific relating to the person's prayer request.*) Amen.

7. End with Closing Prayer for Mission (from *Book of Common Prayer*) and the Lord's Prayer.

*Note: Before beginning the closing prayer, please spend a moment sharing any names of people who come to mind that you might invite to join your Covenant Group.*

**CLOSING PRAYER:** Lord Jesus Christ, you stretched out your arms of love on the hard wood of the cross that everyone might come within the reach of your saving embrace: So clothe us in your Spirit that we, reaching forth our hands in love, may bring those who do not know you to the knowledge and love of you; for the honor of your Name. ### **LOOK –**

3. One way this affects us is by causing us to become overly concerned about what others think of us. Can you think of a way in which you have demonstrated this concern in your life?

### **BOOK – 2 Corinthians 4:3-6**

<sup>3</sup>And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing. <sup>4</sup>In their case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelievers, to keep them from seeing the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. <sup>5</sup>For we do not proclaim ourselves; we proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your slaves for Jesus' sake. <sup>6</sup>For it is the God who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

1. How does the "god of this world" blind the minds of unbelievers? (v. 3)
2. In what ways is it countercultural in today's world NOT to proclaim ourselves? (v. 5)
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5. In this week's Gospel (the story of the Transfiguration), God's voice spoke from heaven to the disciples and said: "This is my Son, the Beloved; listen to him."  
In what ways is listening to Jesus connected to proclaiming him?

### **TOOK –**

1. What are some ways you can point to Christ and proclaim Christ?
2. In what ways might you need to stop proclaiming yourself in order to truly proclaim Christ?
3. In what ways do you feel called to be a "slave for Jesus' sake"?
